Sessional Instructor Position in Petroleum Engineering Geology

The Department of Geoscience at the University of Calgary is seeking a Sessional Instructor to fill 1/3 of the course as lecturer for Geology 377 (Petroleum Engineering Geology).

The position involves instructing lectures and laboratories on introductory exploration geophysics to engineering students as part of the course GLGY 377 (Petroleum Engineering Geology). The topics covered will focus on seismic methods used in petroleum exploration but will also include an overview of gravity and magnetic methods. The duties constitute 1/3 of the course for the Winter 2012 semester.

Applications are currently being accepted for this position. A curriculum vitae, three letters of reference and a statement of teaching experience and philosophy are required.

Applicants are expected to have a Ph.D. in Geoscience or a related field. Previous teaching experience is a strong asset.

The application deadline is **February 09, 2012**. This appointment is effective **March 1st – April 30, 2012**.
